STOKE CHARITY St Mary & St Michael Early Norman Wall paintings Monuments	489392	Retrace steps W to crossroads and take lane NE towards Hunton. Down drive to Norseberry, then E to Norseberry Cottages. E to Weston Colley and Northbrook. S to Micheldever, on crossing river again, turn right (S) to
MICHELDEVER St Mary rebuilt by George Dance the Younger 1806–8	512390	Return to village centre, turn left then right E, taking Chapel Avenue (bridleway) to A33. Cross M3 on bridge then lane to
EAST STRATTON * All Saints TG Jackson 1887–8	541401	Retrace path above, by-passing Micheldever & Stoke Charity on footpaths. At footbridge over the Dever in Hunton take path NE, turning W towards crossroads on old A30. Take road to Norton (NW) At Norton Manor Farm, turn E towards Bullington, crossing under A34
BULLINGTON St Michael restorer <i>E Christian</i> 1871	453412	W to Barton Stacey by road
